SE 1: BIRDING AT THE MARSH

The San Joaquin Wildlife Sanctuary is a 300 acre freshwater wetland in Irvine. A former duck hunting club, it is now a sanctuary where people and wildlife coexist. Gentle trails lead you around ponds where many species of duck, shorebirds, egrets and herons rest and feed. Overhead, osprey and terns look for fish. Lucky visitors may catch a glimpse of the resident bobcat with her kittens. Meet in front of the Audubon House. Wear layers, hats, sunscreen and walking shoes. During construction, entry is off of Campus Drive next to the San Diego Creek channel at University.
